Welcome to The Big Goal Northern Regionals Community Tournament!

Get ready for a full day of football, community, celebration and unforgettable memories. Below is everything you need to know to make the most of your day and tournament experience.

Arrival and Registration

Time: 10:00am - 10:15am

Location: The Simpson Hub

The Simpson Hub is located within Simpson Playing Fields in Hunts Cross and is easily accessible via the A562. Parking is available on-site at the venue.

For all players commuting by public transport, the venue is accessible via local bus and rail services. The nearest bus stops are on Hillfoot Road and Woolton Road, both a short walk from the ground, served by routes including the 76, 81, 166 and 188. The nearest railway station is Hunts Cross, served by Merseyrail, from where the venue is a short taxi or bus journey.

Arrival

Upon arrival at the playing facility, our friendly volunteers and coaches will guide you to the registration desk. Please, where possible, arrive together as a team to ensure a smooth and efficient registration process.

At registration, you will be able to sign your team in for the tournament, scan the official tournament QR code, and then be directed to the changing rooms and preparation area.

The Tournament Platform (via Tournify)

The tournament will be managed digitally using the Tournify tournament platform. After scanning the QR code at registration, players will be able to access all the live stats about the tournament. Fixtures, results, live tournament standings and top scorers will all be available via the link or the app.



Changing Rooms and Preparation

Once registered, you will be directed to the official changing rooms. After changing into your playing kit, please make your way to the pitches, where you will meet your Team Liaison Officer, who will support your team throughout the day and be your main point of contact.

Team Base Areas

Each team will have a designated base area beside the pitches. This is where you can store belongings, rest between matches and prepare for upcoming fixtures. Healthy snacks and refreshments will be available throughout the day from the Refreshments Station.

Official Warm Up: 10:30am - 10:45am

Teams will be called in to take part in a professional group warm-up session led by Everton in the Community Coaches. For safety reasons, no players should enter the playing surface before the official warm-up begins.

Pre-Tournament Group Photo: 10:45am – 10:50am

Immediately following the official warm-up, we will capture a full tournament group photo. Our professional photographer will be capturing individual team photos and images throughout the day as it progresses.

Welcome Address & Tournament Briefing: 10:50am - 10:57am

All teams will be gathered pitch-side following the warm-up and group photo for the official Tournament Welcome Address, where we will set the stage for the competition ahead. Teams will then be directed and move into their designated playing area to meet their Group Referee. Each referee will provide a brief overview of tournament rules and match format before the first games begin.

Tournament Kick Off

First Match: 11:00am

Please ensure your team is ready, prepared and pitch-side for your first fixture. Matches will begin promptly at 11:00am.

Match Schedule

Group Stage Matches: 11:00am - 2:00pm

Teams will compete in a series of group matches throughout the day. Full fixtures and standings will be available via the Tournify platform.

The Big Goal Address

During the afternoon, teams will hear from Street Soccer Foundation Chair, Lord Bailey, who will share the wider vision and impact of The Big Goal movement.

Qualification & Tournament Format

Regional Championship

- All Group Winners automatically qualify for the Semi-Finals
- One Best Runner-Up across all groups will also qualify. This will be determined by:
 - Points
 - Goal Difference
 - Goals Scored

The four Semi-Finalists will automatically qualify for The Big Goal National Finals.

The remaining Group Runners-Up plus the best placed 3rd-place team across all groups will enter the Plate Competition Semi-Finals.

Plate Final

The Plate Final match will take place at approximately 2:45pm.

The team that wins the Plate will also secure their place in The Big Goal National Finals later in the year.

Regional Tournament Final

The final match will kick off at approximately 3:00pm, with all teams and supporters invited to gather pitch-side to watch the final and celebrate the day's competition.

Tournament Officials

All matches will be officiated by FA County Licensed Referees. Our volunteers and club staff will support the smooth running of the tournament throughout the day.

Match results and standings will be updated live via the Tournify platform.

Food and Refreshments

Food and drinks will be available throughout the day within the Community Hub building at the venue. Healthy snacks and refreshments will also be available from the tournament Refreshments Station.

Teams are also welcome to bring their own food and drinks to keep energised throughout the tournament.

Media and Interviews

Throughout the day, you may be invited to take part in interviews with the Street Soccer Foundation media team.

These interviews provide an opportunity to share:

- Your company's reason for supporting The Big Goal
- Your team's journey to the Regional Finals
- Messages of encouragement for the young people supported by the Street Soccer Academy

Your participation helps amplify the social impact of the campaign.

Presentation Ceremony and Awards
